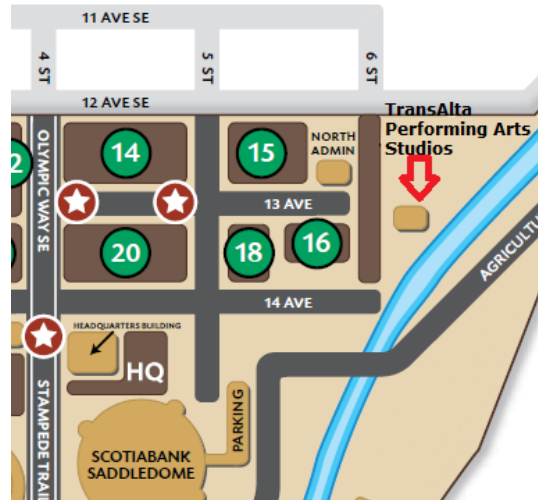
The Young Canadians Studio is located in the TransAlta Performing Arts Studios at Stampede Park. 1302 6 St SE

What is the registration process?

Please complete the online registration form available at www.calgarystampede.com/youngcanadians prior to the audition date or arrive on Friday, July 28 and complete a registration form.

On the day of your audition please sign it at the registration desk to be assigned your audition number and have your photo taken.

Audition Requirements

All **Senior** dance candidates are required to have a minimum of 6+ years of dance training in both Ballet and Jazz.

All **Intermediate** dance candidates are required to have a minimum of 4+ years of dance training in both Ballet and Jazz.

Candidates will be auditioned in a master class setting in front of an audition panel beginning with a jazz class.

After the initial audition segment candidates may be moved into smaller groups to evaluate technical ability, overall execution, and performance capabilities. Candidates may be taught short combinations in a group format during this time for evaluation.

The audition panel may be examining how candidates function in a group environment and perform as part of a team.

Selected individuals will be asked to participate in a mandatory audition workshop the same weekend; Saturday, July 29 and Sunday, July 30, 2017.

Note: Dancers are not required to prepare a dance routine in advance.

What should I wear to the auditions?

Females:

Hair should be in a bun.

Wear Ballet tights and a Black bodysuit

Ballet shoes

Dance Candidates may put on tight fitting
Black Shorts for the jazz class

Jazz shoes will be required

What are we looking for?

We are looking for individuals who adapt well to new situations, learn quickly and are not afraid to step outside of their comfort zone. Remember to be yourself and to have fun, treat it like a class. The audition is also a great opportunity for you to see if TYC is a good fit for you.

General Questions

Can my parents and friends hang out with me during the auditions?

If you are under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must accompany you for the registration process.

We encourage a parent or guardian to wait in the parking lot until you have made it to the end of the callbacks to ensure that you have a ride waiting for you.

Will I need to pay for parking on Stampede Park?

Our new facility, the TransAlta Performing Arts Studios is located just outside of Stampede Park. You may have to pay for parking in lot 14. Please refer to the map.

Please note: For successful candidates, The Young Canadians will provide a parking pass to use when attending classes and rehearsals.

Where to park on Stampede Park?

Please use parking lot 14 or lot 15 on the day of your audition.

Can I audition for Dance and Vocal divisions?

Yes, you may audition for both. Candidates will need to register for both the Dance and the Vocal open call auditions and attend both.

What are the training hours if I'm accepted?

Young Canadian members will train a minimum of four days a week, September to July.
